Dear Ms. Parker,

This correspondence constitutes the Cerritos Community College District's ("District") response to your California Public Records Act ("CPRA") request received by the District via email on December 4, 2022.

You requested the following:

".... copies of all correspondence, decisions, recommendations, and supporting documents available which would be considered public records under the aforementioned Act, which relate to the recent (over the course of October and November) decisions to keep protocols such as Secure Shell (SSH) and ICMP Echo Requests ("pings") blocked for all outbound traffic exiting from the Cerritos College network."

Under the CPRA, a "public record" is defined as, "any writing containing information related to the conduct of the people's business prepared, owned, used, or retained by any state or local agency regardless of physical form or characteristics." (Government Code § 6252(e).)

Exemptions from disclosure are enumerated in Government Code sections 6254 and 6255, and related provisions of the Education Code and Evidence Code.
