This correspondence is in follow-up to my March 29 initial reply and it will serve to provide a final reply to your request.

After reviewing your request against applicable statutory and legal authorities, it has been determined that any documents that may be responsive to your request would be closed pursuant to Chapter 610 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri. As such, there are no documents to provide. Specifically, RSMo 610.021(21), which protects records that identify the configuration of components or the operation of a computer, computer system, computer network or telecommunications network; and RSMo 610.021(22) that pertains to digital certificates, physical and virtual keys, access codes or authorization codes that are used to protect the security of electronic transactions. As stated in previous responses provided to you on other but similar topics, disclosure of the type of information that you request would impair the University's ability to protect the security and safety of its systems and networks and it could expose the University's internal procedures and security controls, all of which are the very things the law protects.

With delivery of this reply to you, we will mark this particular request closed. That said, I would be happy to arrange an in-person meeting with you, me, representatives from Information Technology, and possibly others so that we can hear directly from you what information you are hoping to learn, why, and what, if anything, we can potentially provide insights into. I have spoken with colleagues in IT and they would be willing to participate in such a conversation. If you would be interested in an in-person meeting, please let me know so I can assess how best to proceed.

This is a request for public records under the Missouri Sunshine Law, Chapter 610, Revised Statutes of Missouri, sent on March 26, 2023.

I request that you make available to me any data logged for my SEMO internet access accounts (adhanson1s, S02028878), including but not limited to MAC addresses logged, associated IP address(es), and traffic linked to me (including but not limited packet, TCP session, and DNS traffic records). While I understand that not all data ever associated with me still exists, I ask for all data logged since August 2021, or whatever the largest interval of data available is.

I request that all fees for locating and copying the records be waived. The information I obtain through this request will be used to identify the type of data logged and for how long it is retained, as the scope of what is logged according to <u>SEMO's Network Usage Policies</u> is very broad. This serves the public interest as it gives the public an idea of what SEMO is logging in terms of user data.

If a fee waiver is not granted, please let me know in advance of any search or copying if the fees will exceed \$20.

If portions of the requested records are closed or exempt, please segregate the closed/exempt portions and provide me with the rest of the records.
