Dear Ms Parker:

We received your September 18, 2023 Public Records Act request for the following records:

**Under the California Public Records Act, GOV sec. 7920.000-7931.000 (and in particular under Section 7922.535), I hereby request any documents held by the University pertaining to the NSO Group, or any software developed by the NSO Group; while the request should not be exclusively limited to documents referencing "Pegasus", that may be a helpful term for finding these documents, as that is the primary product of the NSO Group. This should include any documents, presentations, or purchase orders. Most, but not all, records would be located within the University Police Department.**

CSU has conducted a reasonable search for these records under California Government Code §7922.535 and has determined that your request, either in whole or in part, seeks copies of disclosable public records. CSU will make available to you any that are public. Please find the requested information attached.

The California Public Records Act requires CSU to respond to a request within ten calendar days of receipt. The campus is not required to provide the actual records within the ten-day initial response time, but rather, must provide a written response as to whether records will be disclosed or withheld. If any of the records are exempt from disclosure, the written response must explain the basis for the exemption. The response should also include an estimated date when the records will be made available. Cal. Govt. Code §7922.535(a).

Although the California Public Records Act does not expressly indicate a set deadline for disclosing records responsive to a request, it provides that where a request reasonably describes an identifiable record, the record shall be made promptly available. Cal. Govt. Code §7922.530(a). To satisfy this requirement, CSU makes records available for inspection or copying within a reasonable amount of time based on their volume and complexity.
