11124.1(b) Any audio or video recording of an open and public meeting made for whatever purpose by or at the direction of the state body shall be subject to inspection pursuant to the California Public Records Act (Division 10 (commencing with Section 7920.000) of Title 1), but may be erased or destroyed 30 days after the recording. Any inspection of an audio or video recording shall be provided without charge on equipment made available by the state body.

Since the request was evaluated under Bagley-Keene, as per our recent meeting, and the meetings are open meetings (GOV 11123 - the meetings have not been declared closed per the copies of agendas I've received for the meetings), was this section reviewed in the denial?

- Cal. Govt. Code §7927.705; Cal. Const. Art. 1, §1.
- Records that reflect the deliberative, decision-making process of the CSU, which often involves multiple individuals, who need to converse about issues candidly. Cal. Govt. Code §7922.000; Times Mirror Co. v. Superior Court (1991) 53 Cal.3d 1325; Montrose Chemical Corporation of California v. Train (D.DC 1982) 491 F.2d 63; Rogers v. Superior Court (1993) 19 Cal. App.4th 469.
- Records where the public interest against disclosure outweighs the public interest in disclosure.
   Cal. Govt. Code §7922.000.


