Dear Ms Parker:

We received your October 9, 2023 Public Records Act request for the following records:

I hereby request, under Division 10 (commencing with Section 7920.000) of Title 1 of the Government Code (also known as the "California Public Records Act"), copies of **all purchase orders for, or which contained as part of the purchase, security cameras, between October 1, 2021, and September 30, 2023**, not otherwise prohibited from disclosure.

CSU has conducted a reasonable search for these records under California Government Code §7922.535 and has determined that your request, either in whole or in part, seeks copies of disclosable public records. CSU will make available to you any that are public. Records subject to the following exemptions will be withheld or redacted as appropriate:

- Records containing trade secret and/or proprietary information. Cal. Govt. Code §7927.705; Cal. Civil Code §3426, et seq.
- Records of intelligence information or security procedures of a local or state police agency; Cal. Govt. Code §7923.600
- An information security record is exempt from disclosure if, on the facts of a particular case, disclosure would reveal vulnerabilities to attack, or would otherwise increase the potential for an attack on a local agency's information technology system. Cal. Govt. Code §7929.210(a)

We will let you know when we have gathered all the records. It will be necessary to redact from them any personal and otherwise privileged information before they can be made available to you. CSU estimates the records will be available December 18, 2023.

If you wish to inspect the records at California State University, Fullerton, you may contact me to schedule a mutually convenient date and time. If you wish to receive copies instead, CSU may charge the direct cost of duplication (20 cents per page). Once the records are located, we will advise you as

to the exact number of pages upon which any charge will be based. We will require full payment before we begin the redaction and duplication process. The decision that certain records are exempt and will not be disclosed was made by the Records Access Officer at CSU Fullerton, Anne Grogan. Sincerely,

If any segregations are performed, or this request is denied in its entirety, please note that under GOV 7922.540, the names of *all* individuals involved in the denial of the

record must be provided.

Under GOV 7922.535(a), the records must be provided within ten calendar days; as such, please provide the records by no later than October 19, 2023 (with intentional delays to or beyond that point prohibited by GOV 7922.500).
