I write to furnish you

with an update about your public records act request.

We have begun copying documents for you. However, please note that we will not be producing emails that say "11/28" or "11-28" that have no relationship with or reference to the walkout, tuition, SATH, or SQE. That's because every email sent by the individuals you identified on November 28, 2023, contain "11/28" or "11-28."

The California Public Records Act applies to "any writing containing information relating to the conduct of the public's business prepared, owned, used, or retained by any state or local agency regardless of physical form or characteristics." Govt. Code § 7920.530(a). You are not entitled to any and all of the emails sent on November 28, 2023, by the nine individuals you identified. Many of the emails sent on November 28, 2023, pertain to non-CSU business or personnel matters that cannot be disclosed due to the privacy rights of employees.

Cal State LA has begun a reasonable search for the records you requested under the Public Records Act.

Within the next two weeks, we will finish the search and make available to you any records are subject to public disclosure. We will let you know when we have located all of the records and advise you as to which records are subject to disclosure and grounds for any that are not. It will be necessary to redact from otherwise disclosable records any personal and otherwise privileged information before they can be made available to you. Once we have informed you of the availability of disclosable records, you will be able to inspect the records at my office on the 8th Floor of the Student Services Building, [5151 State University Drive, Los Angeles, CA 90032](#), and you may contact me to schedule a mutually convenient date and time. If the records are already in electronic form, we may be able to furnish them to you at no cost. If they are not already in electronic form and you wish to receive copies instead, the Cal State L.A. charge is 20 cents per page. We will advise you when all of the records are located as to the exact number of pages upon which any charge will be based.

I hereby request, under Division 10 (commencing with Section 7920.000) of Title 1 of the Government Code (also known as the "California Public Records Act"), copies of **all emails and texts between October 29, 2023, and November 28, 2023, inclusive, from Chief Larry Bohannon, President Leroy Morishita, Provost Amy Bippus, VP Grace Castillo, VP Queen King, VP Jocelyn Stewart, COS Nancy Wada-McKee, Dean Blanca Martinez-Navarro, and AVP Jennifer Celaya Davis, which contain the keywords "walkout", "SATH", "Students Against Tuition Hikes", "SQE", "Students for Quality Education", "Tuition Rises So Bombs Can Fall", "TUITION RISES SO BOMBS CAN FALL", "tuition rises so bombs can fall", "11/28", or "11-28".**

I am requesting electronic copies of these documents, and as such, no fees should apply; if any documents need to be scanned, please alert me, and I may exert my right to scan the documents myself.

If any documents are nondisclosable, those documents should be segregated, and the disclosable documents provided. If content on/materials in the documents are nondisclosable, those should be redacted pursuant to GOV 7922.525(b).

If any segregations are performed, or this request is denied in its entirety, please note that under GOV 7922.540, the names of *all* individuals involved in the denial of the record must be provided.

Under GOV 7922.535(a), the records must be provided within ten calendar days; as such, please provide the records by no later than December 9, 2023 (with intentional delays to or beyond that point prohibited by GOV 7922.500).

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
